


New To The Ban Xai Project Then Here's A Brief Introduction

After clearing two minefields at Ban Xai, the village council sought assistance for several village projects. When we agreed to help, we sat down together to develop joint project goals. That approach resulted in villagers identifying with and taking ownership of the project and led to them pushing for government support at district, provincial and national levels. Consequently,

government officials at all levels have expedited the approval process and supported MiVAC in every way possible. View the detail of the project.
